# Tasks for March

by Dr. Martin Motes

- 1. Watch for mites.
- 2. Spray for Thrips.
- 3. Repot Genera emerging from dormancy.
- 4. Continue general re-potting of cattleyas, oncidiums, hard cane dendrobiums etc.
- 5. Make top cutting of teretes, semi-teretes and reed stem epidendrums.
- 6. Move landscape plants gradually to brighter light.
- 7. Apply time release fertilizer.
